APPLICATION FOR CIL FUNDING

A proportion of CIL payments collected by Mid Suffolk District Council are passed on to the Parish or Town Council in which development is taking place.

The Parish Council has a duty to spend CIL income on:

 providing, improving, replacing, operating or maintaining infrastructure that supports the development of the parish council area

• anything else concerned with addressing the demands that development places on the area.

Providing CIL is spent in accordance with the above CIL monies may be used to provide seed or match funding with other income streams and / or may be spent collaboratively with other parish councils, community interest companies or other providers to make the most efficient use of funding to benefit the community.

Any CIL monies due to the Parish Council are confirmed by Mid Suffolk District Council at six monthly intervals in March and September with funds being paid to Thurston Parish Council in April and October.

7. Summary of the project proposal	To provide the necessary infrastructure to install 2 No new streetlights on Barton Road between Furze Close and Marley Close
8. Estimated project cost (ex VAT)	 £4,700 to include installation and groundworks. Price includes: Supply and erect 6m galvanised column Supply and erect LED lantern c/w telecell New electrical service no more than 2m away from adjacent LV pole. As new lighting cannot be erected onto UKPN wooden poles, the only option is be to erect standard 6m columns adjacent to the wooden poles.

9. Amount of CIL funding sought	100% is being sought from NCIL due to the requirement of extra street lighting along Barton Road given the provision of further development.

11.Why is CIL funding being sought? Please provide details of sources of funding already considered or applications made for funding?	No other funding has been explored but should traffic management costs be required, then the Council would look to Locality Budgets for further funding.
12. Please indicate whether the organisation has previously received CIL or other funding sources from Thurston Parish Council and/or Mid Suffolk District Council. If yes, please provide details.	CIL funding has been used to provide / maintain a variety of infrastructure which can be viewed in the following files: CIL Spending for year 2022-2023 & MSDC CIL Report for Year 2021-2022. Council has been successful in securing £13,000 from MSDC CIL Infrastructure Pot as a joint project with SCC for the provision of bus shelters in Sandpit Lane and Norton Road.
13. How does the project help address the demands of development in the area. What evidence is there to support this?	Street lighting has a number of important benefits which included the promotion of security; increase in quality of life by artificially extending the hours of light in which activity can take place as well as improvement of safety for drivers, riders and pedestrians. In order to have safer, comfortable, more convenient, efficient movement of vehicles and pedestrians at night time, street lighting or highway lighting is required along the road. At this part of the village, there is limited lighting with many properties set back from the highway.

14. What evidence is there of support from the community	 The need for street lighting is summarised below: street lighting enables all road users to see accurately and easily the carriageway and the immediate surroundings in darkness. Vehicle drivers feel more confident driving under proper street lighting. With better lighting, traffic speed generally improves and traffic flow conditions improve. 	
15. Approximately how many of those who will benefit from the project are Thurston parishioners?	Given the population expansion of Thurston and the increased use of this footpath by development along Barton Road and Mill Lane, it would seem prudent to use the opportunity to offer further lighting to ensure resident safety along this route.	
16. Proposed timescales for the project	Lead time is approximate 13 weeks from receipt of order.	
17. Is there a related revenue spend (i.e. day-to-day running costs) associated with the project? How will this be addressed?	These columns will be owned by Thurston Parish Council and will be added to the inventory for ongoing energy and maintenance as required. Approx. costs for maintenance and ongoing energy costs will be in the region of £200 per annum.
