Principal aims and objectives: SARS provides volunteer clinicians who have additional skills and can carry equipment and drugs which are not found on frontline ambulances. This enables SARS responders to undertake advanced procedures at an incident scene which would not normally be possible outside a hospital environment. These can be truly life-saving interventions as well as having a positive impact on reducing the chances of patients suffering permanent disability and providing relief from pain. This service is provided at no cost to the patient and SARS clinicians are locally based and volunteer in their spare time.

SARS has increased its clinical activity over the last 12 months and our teams responded to over 450 calls for assistance in 2021 including incidents in Thurston and the immediate surrounding area. We are requesting a small contribution from the council to help cover some of the running costs (kit replacement etc..) of our specialist resources. SARS relies on voluntary grants and donations to support and maintain its charitable activity. Due to patient confidentiality we cannot go into specific details on locations etc but we are extremely active in this area and our service is available to the whole community.
