Fresh Start new beginnings is a small local charity offering a therapeutic service for children aged 0-19 living in Suffolk and Norfolk who have been victims of sexual abuse. As well as working with the children, we offer advice, support and information to their families. Fresh Start new beginnings works with the children to help them make sense of the confusion they feel, help them work through painful and often very damaging emotions they may be feeling and to teach them coping strategies to deal with the difficulties they face. Fresh Start new beginnings helps the children to rebuild their futures, helping them to look forward again and feel positive about their lives.

At present we are currently supporting 133 children (99 females, 34 males) in Suffolk and have 61 on the Suffolk waiting list.

We have no children registered with the IP31 3TG postcode, but are currently supporting 4 children from the IP31 postcode,

On average we need approx. £2500 per child to provide this care.

The charity supports over two hundred children a year in Suffolk and Norfolk and on average we have fifty children on our waiting list. However, during the COVID-19 lockdowns, abuse and disclosure rates have increased. We are currently trying to raise awareness of our services and raise funds to help us provide this vital support to all children who need our help. On average, we need around £2,500 per child to provide this care, and as a charity we rely heavily on voluntary donations and fundraising events which sadly the pandemic put a stop to in 2020.
