St Peter's PCC/Church

Receives an annual grant of £1,500 by way of grass cutting for the maintenance of the Churchyard against budget of £1500

Suffolk Libraries

Receives an annual sum of £2,700 by way of donation as a contribution to support Thurston Library and Children's Centre against a budget of £2,700. The sum of £2,700 was paid in 20/21 but as the Library was not open it is expected that this sum will be rolled over to 21/22. The sum of £2,700 for 21/22 is therefore unallocated.
