their location As the open spaces become more mature the maintenance costs increase and in the last Financial Year amounted to almost £8k, additionally the popularity during the lockdown periods have increased the amount of litter generated, to counyer this and provide facilities for all to enjoy the Trustees have been forced into recruiting a litter picker. The open Spaces creates no revenue for the Trust which is normally covered from revenue generated by the hire of the rooms in the centre. Throughout the pandemic, we have attempted to minimise variable costs, however by their nature most of the incurred could be classed as fixed. The Trustees reduced were possible fixed costs including staff, whilst trying to provide as many facilities as possible. With the increasing size of the village population the costs can only increase, and the trustees wish to maintain the standard rather than looking at how they can reduce costs incurred
