Thurston Village Hall Management Committee were invited to apply for an extension to the BIFFA Award received for the refurbishment of the kitchen in September/October 2021, Unfortunately the funding pot was over subscribed nationally therefore other sources of funding have been sought so that w can proceed with this exciting project.

Thurston Village Hall (also known as Cavendish Hall) Management Committee received allocation of £47,000 (staged payments) for the replacement boiler including Air source Heat pump and solar panels. Currently received £9000-00 including contributions from MSD Locality Funding, and CIL funding.
12. How does the project help address the demands of development in the area. What evidence is there to support this?	Thurston Village Hall (also known as Cavendish Hall) Management Committee are constantly listening to our Existing User groups and new potential users of our Village Hall as our village is both expanding and developing. To have a new audio/visual system that will be available alongside the Hearing loop will address some of the demands of the new developments. (see Q13 – re: research undertaken
13. What evidence is there of support from the community	Thurston Village Hall (also known as Cavendish Hall) Management Committee have undertaken research of User groups about what aspects and services could improve the facilities of our Village Hall, to increase future use and ensure that the Hall is more inclusive in its use (the hearing loop), and extending the facilities by the procurement and installation of new audio/visual systems, enabling the facilities to be fit for purpose as we move into 2020s for our expanding community in Thurston. All our User Groups have been informed of the initiative and several of the groups across the spectrum (eg: Scouts, French classes and WI) all responded with enthusiasm and positive statements about the opportunity of having added

	facilities and resources.
14. Approximately how many of those who will benefit from the project are Thurston parishioners?	Their is an average weekly foot fall of between 220>240 users of the Hall with a variant of up to 320 persons if there is an event or party using the facilities. From a recent poll the users were estimated to be 98% from the village of Thurston and the surrounding areas
15. Proposed timescales for the project	It is anticipated that the work will be completed by end of September 2022.
16. Is there a related revenue spend (i.e. day-to-day running costs) associated with the project? How will this be addressed?	There are no related revenue spend, however it has been anticipated that the new facilities will increase rental income from new groups and activities.
