#### CIL SPENDING REVIEW – July 2022 for the year ending 31st March 2023

Neighbourhood CIL is governed by the CIL Regulations and the rate at which it is paid is set out in national legislation. For those Parish Councils with a made Neighbourhood Plan it is 25% (with no CAP) and for Parishes where is no made Neighbourhood Plan it is 15% subject to a cap which is set out nationally (in legislation). The cap is worked out at £100 index linked per occupied property within the parish. The cap rate is set for the year and changes on the 1st January each year. Thurston's NDP was adopted on the 24th October 2019. Any planning permission granted before that date will attract the 15% capped figure, anything granted after that date will attract the 25% uncapped figure.

MSDC overpaid £26,365.12 in April 2021. This means that the payment for April 2022 has been reduced by this amount.

Cap calculation = No of occupied properties x Cap amount Cap amount per occupied property: 01 January 2021 to 31 December 2021 = £149.33 & 01 January 2022 to 31 December 2022 = £148.21. Thurston property numbers: 01 April 2021 to 30 September 2021 = 1480; 01 October 2021 to 31 March 2022 = 1580. Thurston Cap amount: 01 April 2021 to 31 March 2022 = 228,018.10. Thurston Neighbourhood Parish Payments – 21/22: October payment = £160,177.08. April payment = £43,508.94 (Total of income collected within the CAP allowance was £69,874.06 minus £26,365.12 previously overpaid). Difference over the cap limit = £2,033.04 = this amount would be 25% of an

application/s granted after your Neighbourhood Parish Plan was adopted which is not affected by the CAP.

Confirmed by MSDC in an email dated 20<sup>th</sup> April 2022, that any income over the CAP amount for applications for 10+ dwellings will be retained by the Council and ringfenced for spend on Infrastructure projects within Thurston parish.
